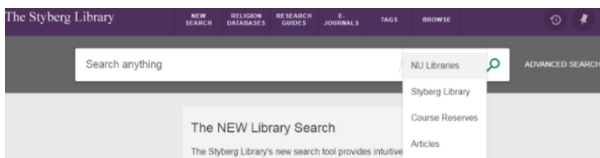

## Searching

1. Enter a keyword, title, author, or subject.
2. Narrow search using the 'Availability' facet.
  - a. Select '**Full Text Online.**'
3. Narrow further using the 'Format' facet.
  - a. Select '**Books.**'

### Styberg Ebooks



Styberg ebooks will have a Styberg Library logo on the login page.

To access Styberg ebooks you will to

- Log in with your GETS ID – first part of your email (e.g., firstname.lastname)

### Northwestern Ebooks



Northwestern ebooks will have a Northwestern logo on the login page.

To access Northwestern ebooks, you will need to

- Log in with NetID (e.g., abc1234)
- Authenticate with a separate device (e.g., phone, tablet, etc.)
